The AIS Scholarship Programme

AIS provides students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds from Amroha with funding amounting to a maximum of Rs 10,000.00 per year for course fees to study at recognized academic institutions beyond high school or college.

Eligibility

- 1. Students must have a grade of 70% or above.
- 2. Student's parents / guardian's income is Rs 10,000.00 per month or less.
- 3. Students have been officially accepted in a recognised course.
- 4. Students must be from Amroha.
- 5. Students must complete all parts of this form including email address and be able to communicate via this email address

To assess eligibility for an AIS Scholarship, the following criteria is applied:

Conditions

- 1. The student must make a commitment to complete the course.
- 2. The student must maintain at least 70% marks during the course.
- 3. Receipt of the money for the first term will be given to an AIS representative before the money for the next term becomes available.
- 4. Student should not have a criminal record.

Supporting Material

All applicants must supply scanned copies of the following via email:

- School / college / university transcripts
- Institution's letter of acceptance for the course indicated in the application form
- Course fee / due form for the institution that is attested by the provost
- Recent digital photograph
- Proof of family income

N.B. A working knowledge of computer skills and use of the internet is highly recommended as information on the sponsor and the student will be displayed on the <u>AIS website</u>, which will allow regular communication between the sponsor and the student and will enable the sponsor to guide and mentor the student.
